On 7th February, 2020, the department made use of the CCA Period to have a Special Talk on “Career Prospects” with Josephine Zonunsangi, Sub. Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl DC. Ms. Josephine talked about the benefits of having a background in literature in the Competitive Examinations, as well as the different career prospects open to students with Literature backgrounds. An illuminating interactive and discussion session followed her talk.

Apart from career prospects, Ms Josephine reminded the students about the importance of hard work and perseverance. She talked about how it is necessary for the students to prepare themselves from the present moment in order for them to succeed in competitive exams, as one cannot gain an immense amount of knowledge overnight. Her talk covered a wide range as she also touched upon the use and misuse of social media, the advantage of reading a newspaper and the advantage that English Literature students have in competitive exams because of their command over the English language. Her talk prompted a number of questions from the students, some of whom had an interest in a career in the civil services. She reminded them of the need to polish oneself on manners and etiquettes as these would give them an edge over other applicants at the time of any job interviews. The Session, attended by 96 students from all semesters, ended with a photo session with the speaker.
